PRO Jerome Josef for providing medicines and service of his physician spouse, PP Dindo Santos and IPP Vincent Santos, two of the medical doctors involved in the patients' health consultation, our very own City Mayor, PE Del de Guzman, and City Vice-Mayor, PP Fabi Cadiz, and our fellow Rotarians who participated and exerted effort to support the said project namely VP Dodjie Cabalquinto, Treas. Bernard Cansana, Dir. Cris Merino, Dir. Hermi dela Paz, PP George Ty, PP Dante Verano, AG Rene Reside of RC Marikina Hilltop and my ever diligent Secretary, Allan Perez.

We planted 150 varieties of tree seedlings in the surroundings of Greenbrier Subd. and there were a total of 200 patients who benefited from the free health consultations and given free medicines. 40 patients had chest x-rays, 25 patients received examination for Blood Sugar, 40 patients examined for Cholesterol, 30 patients had bone scanning, 20 patients for PAP smear, 50 patients for ECG, 20 patients had tooth extractions and almost 100 patients were checked for their visual acuity.

The Tree Planting and the Integrated Community Health Services is a joint project commissioned by RC Marikina and RC San Mateo and I am extremely grateful to the flock of our partners in service such as the Inner Wheel Club of Marikina headed by its President, Liza Masangkay, along with her group are Sps. Elay Fidelino, Sps. Vising dela Paz, Sps. Leonor Ty, Sps. Zeny de Guzman and Leah Ty. The Marikina Valley Medical Society and their Auxiliary, the Volunteer Dentists, RCC, Mobile Optical Clinic, Drug Companies and of course to the Management and Staff of St. Ignatius de Loyola Health Care Services for providing the Free Mobile X-Ray and Pap Smear.

Prior to conducting the three-in-one project in San Mateo, on July 1, 2010, IPP Vincent, together with VP Dodjie, Dir. Hermine, Dir, Pat, Sec Allan and yours truly, spearheaded the donation of a set of computer in H. Bautista Elementary School. This donation was in response to one of the school's requests after the massive destruction they suffered from typhoon Ondoy.

Council approves fifth Avenue of Service

Representatives at the 2010 Council on Legislation approved an enactment 28 April to add a fifth Avenue of Service: New Generations.

After adopting an amendment to change the name from Youth Service, as originally proposed, to New Generations, the Council narrowly supported the addition to article 5 of the Standard Rotary Club Constitution. The 263-250 vote was received by surprised gasps and applause after a short debate.

New Generations joins Club Service, Vocational Service, Community Service, and International Service as the foundation of club activity. Before starting a project, Rotarians are asked to think broadly about how their club and its members could contribute within each avenue.

"It's a significant change – a historic day in Rotary," said Council Chair Mark Daniel Maloney. "Rotarians have always strongly supported youth activities even though they were never part of the four Avenues of Service. I think this strengthens our commitment."

The Avenue of New Generations recognizes the positive change implemented by youth and young adults involved in leadership development activities, community and international service projects, and exchange programs that enrich and foster world peace and cultural understanding.

Representative Ronald P. Sekkel, of District 5170 (California, USA), proposed the enactment by saying that New Generations is the future of Rotary.

Opponents argued that youth services are already covered by the four Avenues of Service. One representative said that adding a fifth avenue could decrease emphasis on the other four avenues.

Representative Emile M. Rijcken, of District 1900 (Germany), said the new avenue is well deserved. "The volume of activity in youth programs shows how strong Rotary can be," she said. "The addition of New Generations to the Avenues of Service will contribute in an enormous way toward public opinion."


