Before our meeting was held last week, our group composed of yours truly, VP Dodjie, Sec. Allan and PP Tony visited one of our adopted schools, the H. Bautista Elementary School, last Thursday, September 23 at 10AM, to donate our 2nd set of computers for their needs. School Principal Emma Cruz and their staff gladly received our donation through a simple and meaningful ceremony conducted at the Principal's office.

Then on Saturday, September 25, the Zone Interact Assembly and STAR program of our club were simultaneously held in separate venues. The Zone Interact Assembly was done in Roosevelt College in Sumulong. A total of 150 interactors attended the assembly that came from the 12 clubs of our zone including the 21 delegates of our club. Then on the other hand, was the 1st ever STAR program which was accomplished in MRYC. For your information STAR Program was one of the RI Thrusts to receive an RI citation. It is also one of the goals of our District to bring Rotary Academy on the club level. The forum was spearheaded by PP Ver Farcon. There were about 20 Baby, not so old and veteran Rotarians who graced the discussion. CP Manny Reyes of RC Rizal Centro was the top caliber keynote speaker. He discussed how Rotary was formed and some basic knowledge in Rotary.

On the following day, 9AM, Sunday, September 26, the City Government of Marikina, headed by PE Mayor Del, PP Vice-Mayor Fabi and Rtn. Administrator Vic Sabiniano led a Tree Planting project to commemorate the 1st year anniversary of typhoon Ondoy. Our club has revived a very valuable informative Rotary Program last Saturday, the STAR (Special Training for Action in Rotary) Program thru the chairmanship of our very own “RC Marikina Walking Rotary Encyclopedia” PP Ver Farcon. He is ably supported by a committee composed of PP Flor de la Paz, PP Dante Verano, PP Onie Aguinaldo, Director Hermie de la Paz. There were 19 club members who attended the first session of the STAR Program that is slated for twelve monthly or one year session. This program is designed not only for new members but is open to all Rotarians who want to review and update themselves of the basic of Rotary.

The STAR program was developed by the Rotary Club of El Paso, Texas, USA, in 1976. It is a method that can be used to involve and engage new members while preparing members for club leadership positions. This is a must for all Rotarians who want to earn the benefit of leadership development. In addition to serving as a vehicle for Rotary information, the STAR breakfasts help new members get acquainted with each other as well as becoming familiar with a few of the club’s more experienced Rotarians. His topic was about the basics of Rotary, Objectives, history of Rotary in the Philippines. Did you know that Gil J. The STAR Program assures anyone who religiously attends to learn more than just attending regular meetings and listening to our club rotary information tidbits. Typical STAR Program meetings may feature a welcome to first-time attendees, recognition of new STAR graduates, announcements of upcoming club and district activities and events. 

CAUSES OF CLIMATE CHANGE (Continuation)

Solar output



Variations in solar activity during the last several centuries based on observations of [sunspots](#) and [beryllium](#) isotopes.

The sun is the predominant source for [energy](#) input to the Earth. Both long- and short-term variations in solar intensity are known to affect global climate.

Three to four billion years ago the sun emitted only 70% as much power as it does today. If the atmospheric composition had been the same as today, liquid water should not have existed on Earth. However, there is evidence for the presence of water on the early Earth, in the [Hadean](#) and Archean eons, leading to what is known as the **faint young sun paradox**. Hypothesized solutions to this paradox include a vastly different atmosphere, with much higher concentrations of [greenhouse gases](#) than currently exist. Over the following approximately 4 billion years, the energy output of the sun increased and atmospheric composition changed, with the [oxygenation of the atmosphere](#) around 2.4 billion years ago being the most notable alteration. These changes in luminosity, and the sun's ultimate death as it becomes a [red giant](#) and then a [white dwarf](#), will have large effects on climate, with the red giant phase possibly ending life on Earth.

Solar output also [varies](#) on shorter time scales, including the 11-year [solar cycle](#) and longer-term [modulations](#). Solar intensity variations are considered to have been influential in triggering the [Little Ice Age](#), and some of the warming observed from 1900 to 1950. The cyclical nature of the sun's energy output is not yet fully understood; it differs from the very slow change that is happening within the sun as it ages and evolves. While most research indicates solar variability has induced a small cooling effect from 1750 to the present, a few studies point toward solar radiation increases from cyclical sunspot activity affecting [global warming](#).

Orbital variations

Slight variations in Earth's [orbit](#) lead to changes in the seasonal distribution of sunlight reaching the Earth's surface and how it is distributed across the globe. There is very little change to the area-averaged annually averaged sunshine; but there can be strong changes in the geographical and seasonal distribution. The three types of orbital variations are variations in Earth's [eccentricity](#), changes in the [tilt angle of Earth's axis of rotation](#), and [precession](#) of Earth's axis. Combined together, these produce [Milankovitch cycles](#) which have a large impact on climate and are notable for their correlation to [glacial](#) and [interglacial periods](#), their correlation with the advance and retreat of the Sahara, and for their appearance in the [stratigraphic record](#).

Up Close and personal with PDG James Dee

Many Rotarians have assumed District leadership positions but only one is carefully selected as the PCRG Chair. After thorough selection process from the ten Rotary District Directors in the Philippines, Rotary perfectly named the right person to chair and mentor this year's Philippine College of Rotary Governor (PCRG) in the character of Jaime "James" O. Dee. He was born to lead and serve and whose words and actions match. His perseverance and diligence anchored by his Christian values can be attributed to his late father Francisco Dee, a successful businessman who enlightened him the significance of hard work while Elvira Ong Dee a doting and inspiring mother.



With his bright upbringing, he finished a Bachelor's Degree in Electrical Engineering at Mapua Institute of Technology. Thereafter, his solid academic foundations and his multi lingual skill brought him to manage more than a dozen business entities and eventually carved his name in the assembly of successful businessmen in the country. His life experiences molded and shaped him and further developed his perspectives and passions essential to the capacity of his leadership.

Having been prominent in the business field, Rotary Club of Malabon found its way to him. His love for service and dedication to leadership was fortified when he finally joined Rotary in 1990. From then onwards he became one of the key players in their club service projects and functions.

After eight years, he was elected as the club's president. His unstoppable year after year's key positions in the **District** eventually **hailed him as the Leading District Governor in 2006-2007**. Consequently, PDG James was elected with the following positions as District Chair, Public Image (RY 2008-09); District Chair, Membership (RY 2008-09); District Chair, TRF Annual Giving (RY 2009-10); Chair - Ways & Means, Rotary Institute Manila 2009; District Chair, Service Projects (RY 2010-11); Trustee PRMF (RY 2010-11). He is a multiple Paul Harris Fellow, a benefactor of the Rotary Foundation's Permanent Fund and a major donor to the Rotary Foundation.

With his demonstration of good leadership, he became a well sought after speaker, discussion leader, resource person, and workshop facilitator. Among his many participations and experiences in Rotary were his presence in various District and International conferences; in Barcelona, Spain 2002; Osaka, Japan 2004; DGN Training in Bangkok, Thailand 2004; Chicago Illinois 2005; Zonal Institute held in Manila and Bangkok; R.I. Presidential Conference in Manila and Taipei, Taiwan; DGE Training in Manila 2005; and Training for District Governor culminated in San Diego, California in 2006.

For his outstanding achievements in Rotary PDG James has received numerous awards and citations for his various services. To name a few, he was a TOM Awardee in Community Service (The Outstanding Mapuan Awardee 2008), Most Outstanding Rotarian Award in the Rotary Club of Malabon twice and Rotary International Four Avenues of Service Citation for Individual Rotarians.


